

Members Code of Conduct

Membership of the Seniors Rights Service is at the discretion of the Board.

All members are required to support and agree to the organisation's Charitable Purpose¹ and Constitution².

In addition, members are required to comply with the following terms and conditions. Membership is conditional on the member:

- Demonstrating respect and courtesy to staff, Board members, and contracted service providers of the organisation
- Complying with any reasonable instructions given by staff, Board members, or contracted service providers
- Demonstrating respect and courtesy to other members of the organisation and other users of its facilities and services
- Ensuring the member's actions do not cause disruption to the organisation's programs or other users
 of its facilities and services
- Ensuring the member's actions do not put at risk the safety of staff, contracted service providers or other users of facilities and services
- Ensuring the member's actions do not cause damage to the organisation's premises or their contents
- Ensuring the member's actions do not harm the operations or reputation of the organisation
- Only participating in those events or activities for which they are registered in accordance with the organisation's rules and procedures

In accordance with the constitution of the organisation, failure to comply with any of the conditions in this code of conduct may be grounds for cessation of membership.
